The games, camera and MP3 player on the PDA mean that he can have some fun with it too.

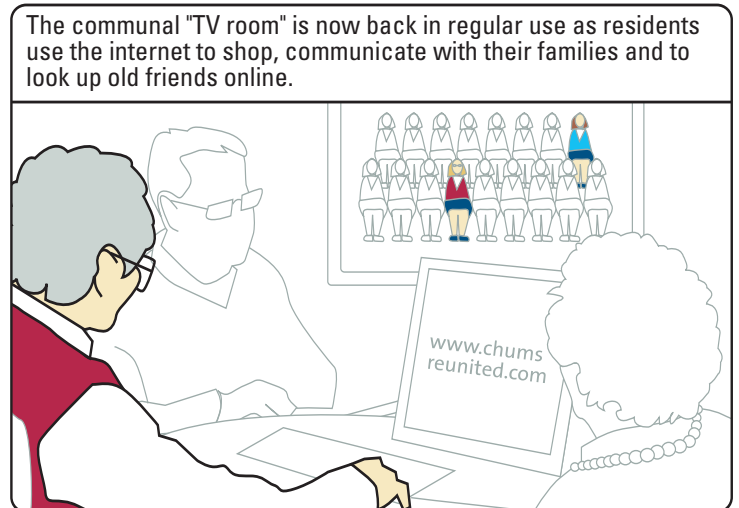
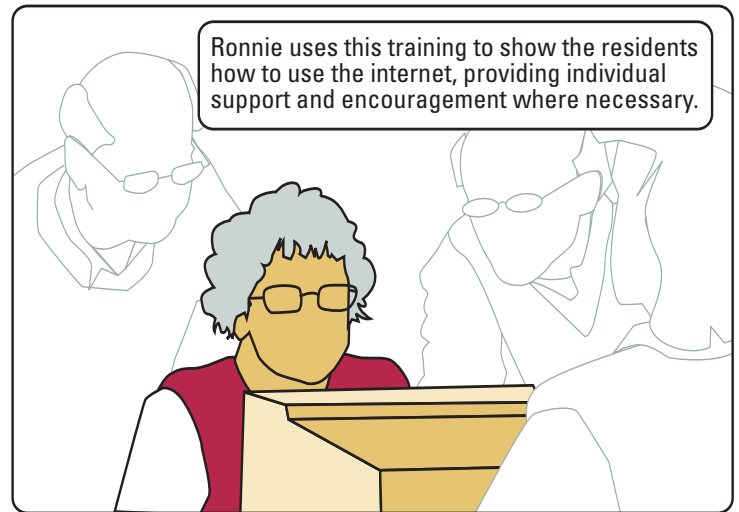
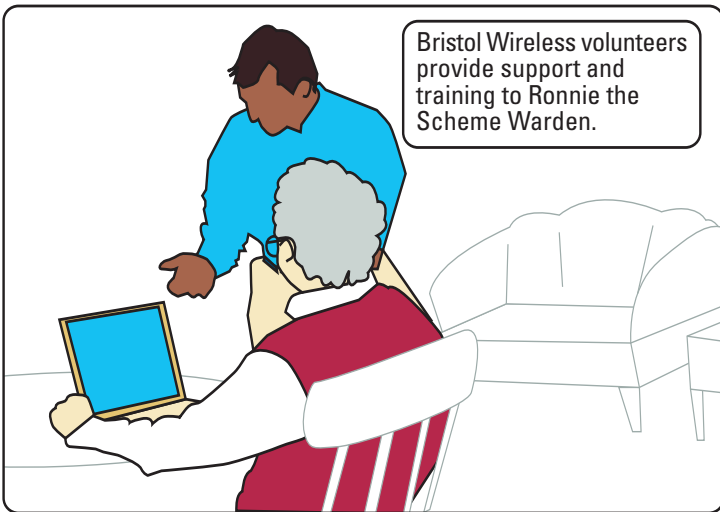
Chris's teacher offers him a PDA to help him with his school work. She takes him through the main functions showing him how to get started.

The traffic congestion in town is always terrible.



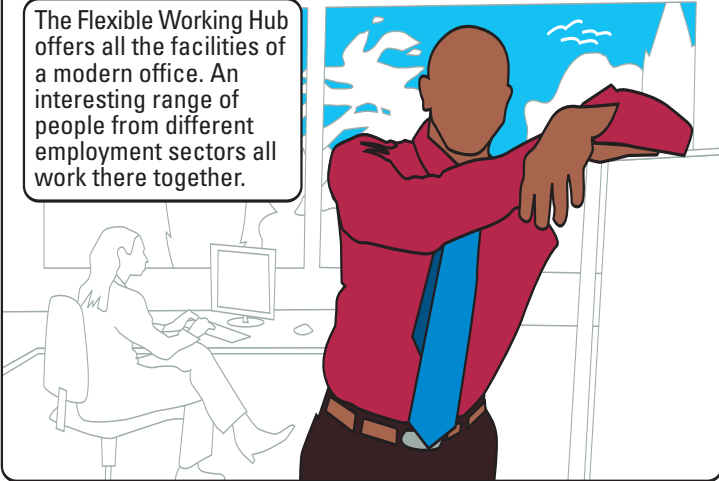
Anne is regularly held up by traffic jams on her way to work and often arrives at work late and highly stressed.



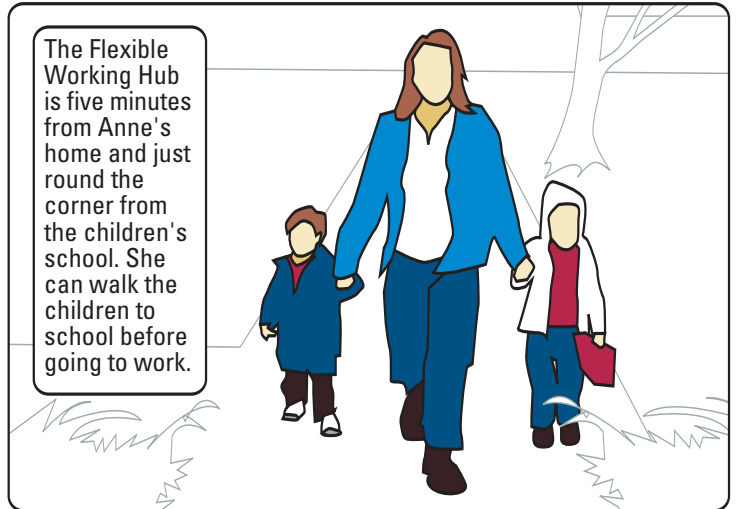
Anne's boss tells her about the Flexible Working Hub near her home and offers her the chance to try working from there a few days a week.



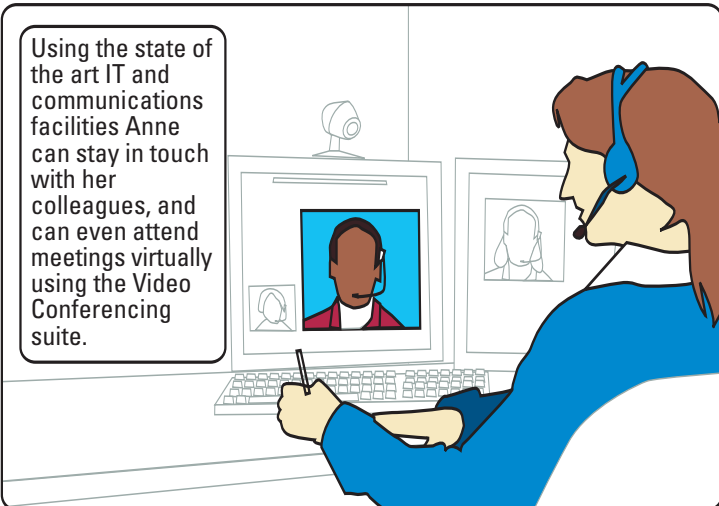
The Flexible Working Hub offers all the facilities of a modern office. An interesting range of people from different employment sectors all work there together.
